### **Announcement & Conditions of Participation**

The Sparkasse Aachen, the Rheinische Sparkassen- und Giroverband and the Aachen-Laurensberger Rennverein e.V. announce the contest “Silver Camera” for the best international equestrian photograph of the year 2010 / 2011. The award will be presented on the occasion of the World Equestrian Festival, CHIO Aachen 2011 (July 8<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>).

A jury of experts will determine the winner and present the awards.

In addition to the “Silver Camera” trophy, the winner will receive a prize money of EUR 2.500,-, the second-placed receives a prize money of EUR 1.000,- and the third-placed a prize money of EUR 500,-. The photographs on the short list will be exhibited in the Sparkassen-Meeting Point during the World Equestrian Festival, CHIO Aachen 2010.

### **Conditions of Participation:**

1. Final closing date for the contest is **April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011**.
2. Only professional photographers are entitled to take part in the contest.
3. The photographs showing equestrian sport scenes from around the world must have been taken between May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 and April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
4. The participant declares to be the sole author of the submitted photographs.
5. Each participant may submit a maximum of three different photographs (colour or b/w).
6. Pictures have to be submitted digitally (Format TIF, JPG or BMP), with a minimum size (circa) of 20 x 30 cm and a solution of 300 dpi. Participants have to provide information on the pictures' titles, the name of the photographer as well as on the date and place where the photographs were taken.
7. The submitted photographs will only be used by the organizers in conjunction with the contest and its medial presentation.
8. The competitors may not claim any royalty rights for the publication of their pictures that happens in conjunction with the contest. The right for publication in conjunction with the contest belongs to the contest's organisers.
9. Further commercial use of the photos has to be agreed between the photographer and the respective publisher(s) independently of the contest's organizers.
10. Submitted CDs will only be returned upon request and at own risk.
11. The jury's decision is final and cannot be contested by any legal action.
12. Participation in the "Silver Camera Award" is subject to acceptance of the above conditions. In case that pictures do not comply with the conditions of participation, they may be rejected by the jury. Also the organisers can submit photographs of their own choice.
13. The winners will be contacted personally. Therefore the participants are required to send their complete contact data, including home address, telephone number and E-Mail address.
